

A) Privacy Policy

Your privacy is very important to us and we are committed to protecting it. This Privacy Policy explains how and why we collect personal data from you and how we use it.

By visiting the REcampus.com web site or any of the sites that are co-branded with REcampus.com and one of our partner schools ("REcampus.com Network" or the "Sites") or submitting your personally identifiable information to us, you accept the terms described in this Privacy Policy. From time to time we may modify these terms. We will notify you of any material change by posting a notice on the home page of this site that the policy has been updated and by changing the date on this page noting when the policy was last updated. Your continued use of the Sites after any modification indicates your agreement to the new terms.

Information We Collect

Personally Identifying Information. When you register for courses, purchase products from our Bookstore, request information from us on our Sites, and at other times, we will collect personally identifying information from you, such as your name, address, e-mail address, credit card information and, in some cases, your social security number ("personal data"). In addition, if you send us an e-mail or communicate with us offline, we may collect the personal data that you voluntarily provide us at that time.

Anonymous Information When you visit the REcampus.com Network we may automatically collect anonymous data that is not linked to your personal data, such as your IP (Internet Protocol) address, browser type, operating system, domain name, access times, referring web site addresses and web site usage information. This information helps us evaluate how our visitors use and navigate our Sites, including the number and frequency of visitors to each Web page, and the length of their visits.

How We Use Your Information

We may use your personal data in the following ways:

- For the purpose for which you specifically provided the personal data, for example to provide one of our online courses, or to deliver the results of exams and assignments, or to respond to a specific inquiry.
 - To the extent you are a student of one of our partner schools, to allow such partner school to administer your student records.

To send you notifications about your accounts or transactions with us and to otherwise

- contact you with information that we believe will be of interest to you.
 - To enhance existing features or develop new features, products and services.

Sharing Your Information

Our Partner Schools. If you enroll in a course through one of our partner schools or on one of our co-branded partner school web sites, all of the personal data that you provide is accessible by and provided to that partner school for administration purposes, such as keeping track of your course records, accepting and recording your payments, providing you with certificates of completion, and complying with any state reporting requirements. The partner schools are not governed by this Privacy Policy. If you want to know more about a partner school's use of your information, contact the school directly.

Other Third Parties. We may hire other companies to perform services on our behalf including, without limitation, facilitating some aspects of the Sites, sending e-mail and fulfilling purchase and other requests. These other companies may be supplied with or have access to your personally identifiable information solely for the purpose of providing these services to us or on our behalf.

We may also need to disclose your personal data to third parties if we, in our sole discretion, believe it is required by law, to enforce our User Agreement or this Privacy Policy, protect our intellectual property rights, or when we, in our sole discretion, believe it is necessary or appropriate, in connection with or as the result of a change in ownership of all or a portion of the REcampus.com site as the result of a merger, acquisition or transfer to another company. We also may disclose or use your personal information when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires us to do so.

Other than these limited exceptions, we will not share your personal data without your permission.

Transfer to the United States If you are located outside of the United States, please note that the personal data you provide to us will be transferred to the United States. Whenever you submit any personal data to us, you consent to this transfer.

Cookies We use cookies to allow you to move quickly through our Sites, streamline the login process, keep track of your shopping cart, preserve order information between sessions and to allow you to take advantage of some of the Sites' special features. We also use cookies to collect site usage information, estimate our total audience size and traffic and to help us improve our sites' experiences by measuring which areas are of greatest interest to users.

A cookie is a string of information that is sent by a web site and stored on your hard drive or temporarily in your computer's memory. Cookies are small files and won't pose any significant disk-space concerns. Some cookies used by our Sites may remain on the user's computer after they leave the web site.

You can turn off the ability to receive any of these cookies by adjusting the browser in your computer. The Help menu on the menu bar of most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether. Without cookies you can visit our Sites, but you will not be able to use the products or services that require you to sign in and you may not be able to take full advantage of some of the useful and convenient features, such as saving and accessing your shopping cart and order information.

In an effort to provide you with the most relevant content and marketing materials, we may also use embedded pixel technologies (e.g., web beacons) to help track site usage and response to our marketing campaigns. The anonymous information we capture through this mechanism is not linked to your personal data.

Security We are concerned with the security of your personal data. To keep that data secure, we restrict unauthorized access through protective policies, procedures, and technical measures. In addition, we use standard security protocols and mechanisms to transmit sensitive data such as credit card details.

Links to Other Web Sites The Sites may contain links to other web sites, including other Kaplan company sites and regulatory web sites. This Privacy Policy covers only the REcampus.com Network and not these other sites – including the other Kaplan sites. Be sure to look for the privacy policies that govern your use of these other web sites.
